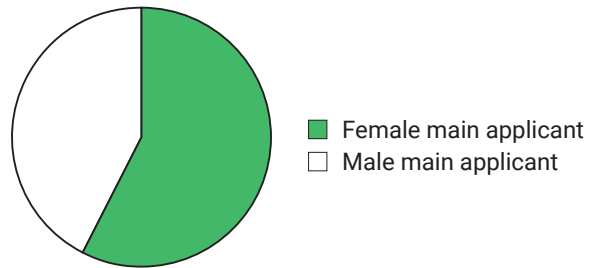


Key Performance Indicators for new projects in 2016

(Values in parentheses are for 2015)

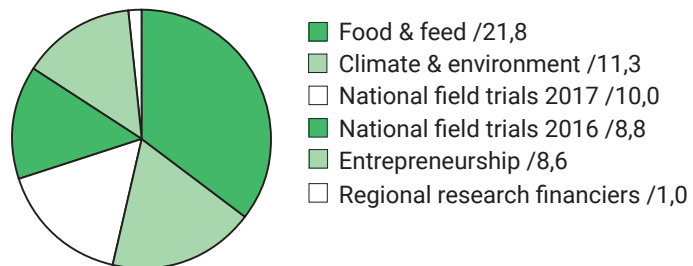
Female and male main applicants

Of 23 (28) approved applications for new projects 61 % (63) had a female main applicant and 39 % (37) a male main applicant.



Means per sector

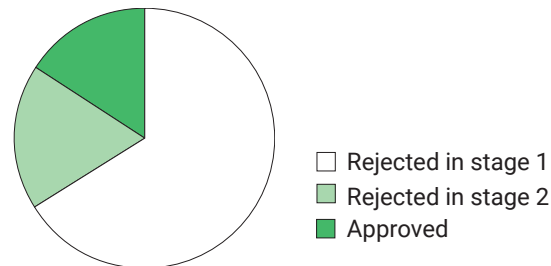
The focus area food & feed was by far the biggest sector, followed by the focus area climate & environment and the national field trials (for 2017 and 2016). The amounts are rounded and are stated in million Swedish kronor (SEK).



Granting grade

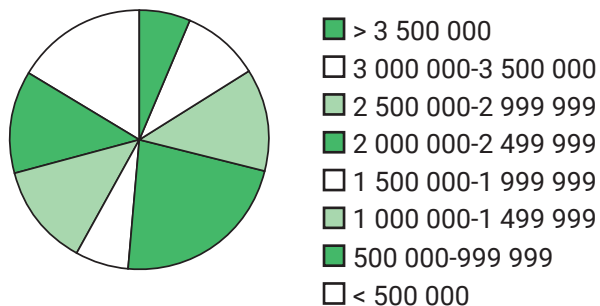
The open call

121 concept overviews were received in the open call. Out of these, 41 applicants were presented with the opportunity of sending in a full-scale application. 19 of the projects were granted. The granted grade calculated on full-scale applications was 46 %. The granted grade calculated on concept overviews was 15 %.



Project size

The average size of the 30 projects that were granted in 2016 was 1,8 million SEK (2,1)* and the median size was 2,0 million SEK (1,9).

Distribution to organizations

10 (11) organizations were granted means in 2016. The major receiver was SLU with 52 % (56) of the projects and 50 % (57) of the granted means.
